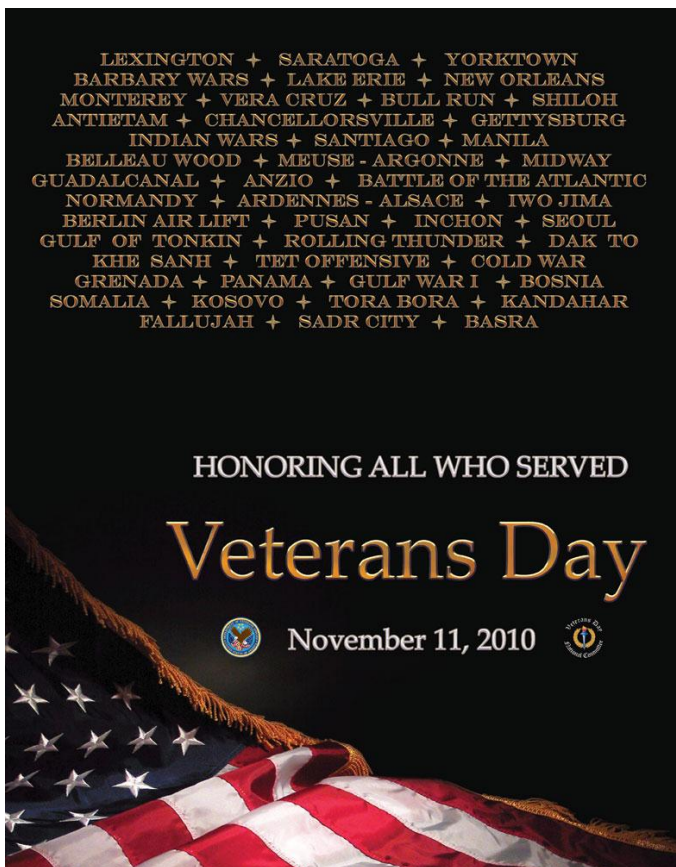

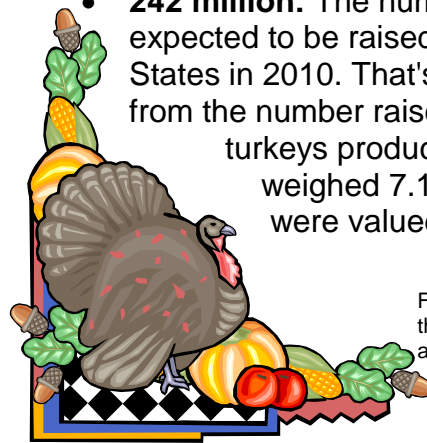
1. Feed me and I live. Give me a drink and I die. What am I?
